

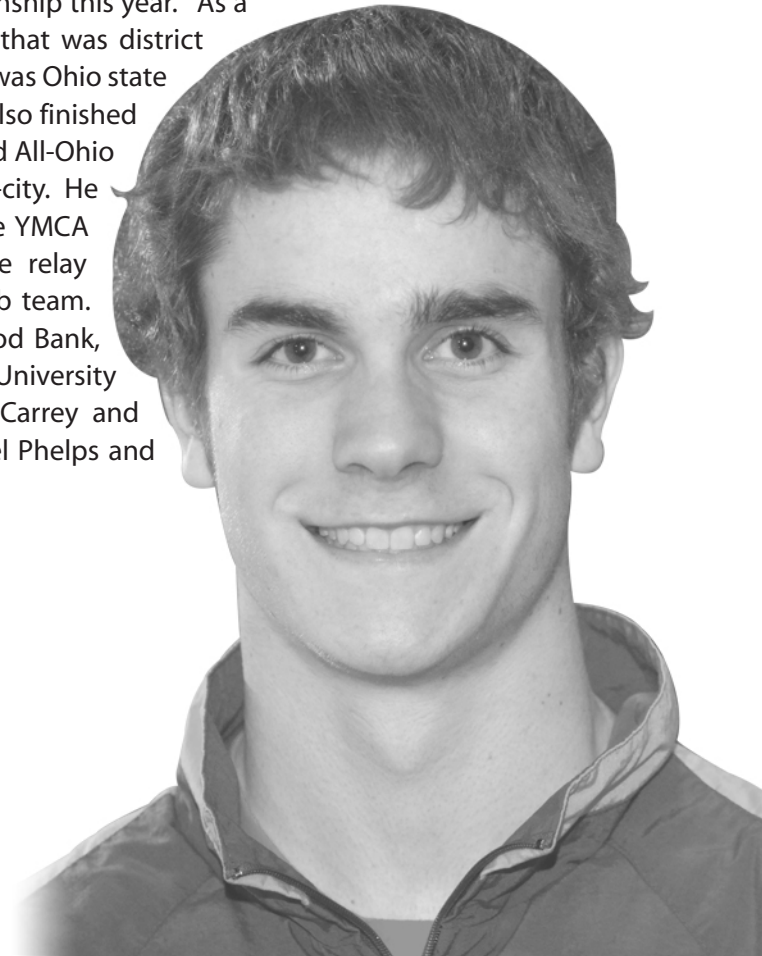

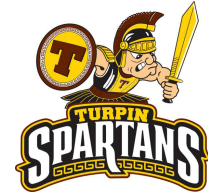
Kyle Greene

He has earned All-American and All-Ohio honors in 4 different events and was named 1st team all-city. He holds several school records and in 2004 was on the YMCA national champion and record-setting 800 freestyle relay team. He also swims for the M.E. Lyons YMCA club team. Very active in community service, including the Food Bank, and a good student, Kyle will swim next year at the University of Kentucky.
