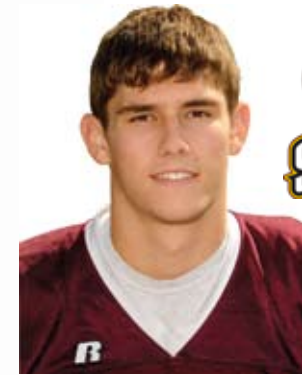
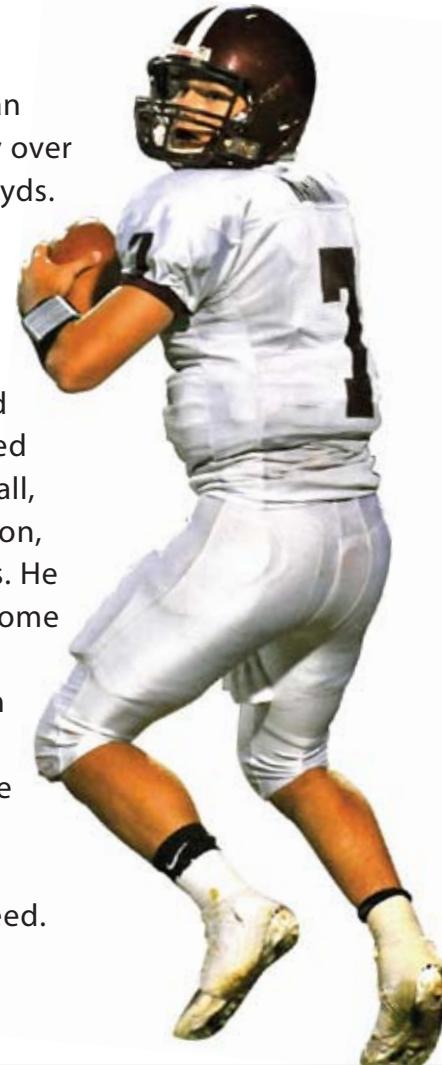
Turpin High School
