



Will Pfennig Mason High School



A three-year varsity starter in baseball, Mason pitcher Will Pfennig had a senior season to remember for the 26-6 Comets who were GMC, District and Regional champs, and an Ohio state semifinalist.

On the mound, Will notched a 9-1 record with a school-record 115 strikeouts in 66 2/3 innings of work. He also had three shutouts and a 1.16 ERA. He was named GMC and Cincinnati Pitcher of the Year and was 2nd team all-state.

Will had numerous big games. In the district semifinals, Will beat Oak Hills 4-1, pitching a complete game 1-hitter, striking out 11 batters while allowing just one unearned run. He then threw a three-hitter with nine strikeouts in a 3-2 regional semifinals' win vs. Centerville.

His junior year, he went 6-2 on the mound with 47 strikeouts in 36.2 innings pitched and had a 3.06 ERA. He earned 2nd team all-GMC honors.

A Cum Laude student with a 4.45 GPA, Will is active in community service and will play collegiately at The Ohio State University, where he plans to major in chemical engineering.
