Like his spring sport counterpart athletes this season, Lakota East's 2020 graduate and baseball all-star Nathan Haberthier had his senior season of competition wiped out by the coronavirus pandemic.

Nathan didn't get the opportunity to follow up on a super junior season. In 2019, Nate, a right-handed pitcher, on the mound was 7-1with a 1.10 ERA and 72 strikeouts in 61 innings for the Thunderhawks. He became one of only eight Lakota East pitchers ever to throw a no-hitter, when he pitched a five-inning no-hit shutout as East defeated Dayton Stebbins 18-0. He had 11 strikeouts in the game. He also had 10 strikeouts in a 6-1 win vs. Colerain.

His seven wins was second most in the GMC, and his 72 strikeouts was third in the GMC. His career pitching record is 12-2 with 119 strikeouts and a 1.68 ERA.

Nate helped Lakota East finish second in the GMC with a 21-6 overall record, 16-2 in league play. For his efforts, Nate was recognized with numerous honors, including being named first team all-GMC, first team all-city and honorable mention all-Ohio.

His summer team is the Cincinnati Flames and he will play baseball collegiately at the Ohio State University.
